MARKER INFORMATION

Veterans and eligible spouses and dependants are entitled to a **Standard Government Marker** issued by the VA at no cost. Please review the attached information sheet and provide the information below, being sure to verify all the marker information for accuracy. Every marker will be inscribed with Name, Branch of Service, Dates of Birth and Death, Rank, Awards, and Period of Service. Emblem of Belief and Personal Remarks are optional and not required.

Those eligible for burial in the Vermont Veterans Memorial Cemetery (VVMC) whose remains have been scattered, buried at sea, or are unavailable for any other reason, may have a flat government marker placed in the **Memorial Garden at the VVMC**. Contact our office for further information or questions.

The Office of Veterans Affairs must receive this document within 5 business days of the interment. If we do not receive this form with 5 days of the interment, markers will be ordered without the optional Emblem of Belief or Personal Remarks.

We will not reorder a stone unless factual information is incorrect or the stone is damaged.

C. STANDARD GOVERNMENT MARKERS

UPRIGHT TYPES:

These headstones, which come in both granite and marble, are 42 inches long, 13 inches wide and 4 inches thick.

Weight is approximately 230 pounds.

FLAT TYPES:

The flat markers, which also come in both granite and marble, are 24 inches long, 12 inches wide, and 4 inches thick. Weight is approximately 130 pounds.
